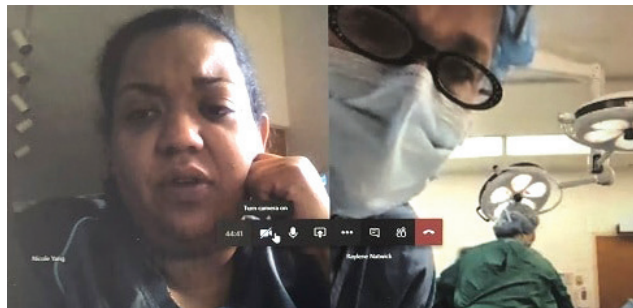
On-Demand Clinical and HCP Support During COVID-19

Factors for Successful Virtual Case Support

Prior to the procedure date, Dr. Natwick discussed the case with her SCOUT clinical specialist and, after a quick video/sound test, scheduled a Microsoft Teams meeting for the procedure date and time. On the day of surgery,

Dr. Natwick used a cell phone to join the video meeting, and assigned a charge nurse to manage the phone and video conference during the procedure.
